D.R.D.A, Ranchi invites sealed tenders/quotations for supply of various grafted/air - layered/budded true-to-type, healthy and vigorous fruit plants. The sealed tenders may be submitted on any working day on or before 3-00 pm on dated 21-05-07. The tenders will be opened at 4-00 pm on the same day in the presence of suppliers or their authorized representatives. Earnest money of Rs. 20,000.00

(Rupees twenty thousand only) in form of demand draft of any nationalized bank drawn in favour of D.D.C, Ranchi will have to be attached with the tender paper failing which the tender will not be considered.

1. Oversized plants (total height more than 100 cm will not be preferred.
2. Preference will be given to the plants raised in polythene bags. Plants grown in nursery beds after grafting /budding/air layering and later transferred in polythene bags will not be accepted.
3. The plants should have aluminums tags with the name of the variety and suppliers name printed on it.
4. Preference will be given to suppliers having proof of genuineness of verities certified by the State Agricultural Universities/State Department of Agriculture / Horticulture/Public Sector Institutions.
5. The required fruit plants will have to be supplied to 20 Blocks of Ranchi District for plantation of trees/development of orchard in approx. 5,000 acres of land.
6. Payment of 90 % of the total cost of the plants will be made on satisfactory supply up to the destinations. Rest 10 % of total cost will be released. One month after supply upon assessment of mortality of plants

in the field Deduction from the total cost will be made for plant mortality due to poor quality of plants.

7. The successful supplier will be required to supply the fruits plants within 10 days of issue of supply order.
8. Rate should be quoted for delivery up to the final destinations at Block Headquarters (F.O.R) inclusive of all expenses.
9. If the supplier fails to supply the planting material within the stipulated time, the supply order will be cancelled and earnest money will be forfeited without any further notice.
